RENT COLLECTION POLICY

Below are some of our general policy statements for the collection of rent. If you have any questions please feel free to contact the office.

• RENT IS DUE IN FULL ON THE FIRST OF EACH MONTH

- PLEASE INCLUDE APARTMENT NUMBER on the check or money order
- **RENT IS LATE** (in arrears) if it is not paid by the tenth (10th) of the month
- LATE FEES on the 11th of the month a late fee of \$10 will be charged. Thereafter \$1 for each day rent is not paid, not to exceed \$30 dollars per month
- MONEY ORDERS ONLY...once you have had 2 checks returned to us we can not accept your rent payment in any form except for money order or certified bank check NOTICE TO QUIT... once you have been served with a notice to quit for unpaid rent by our Attorneys you will be responsible for all legal and court fees involved in accordance with your lease.

ARE YOU DUE FOR YOUR ANNUAL RECERTIFICATION?

Recertification is extremely important. If you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment please call the office to reschedule. When you come in for your appointment please bring in your completed questionnaire, along with the name and addresses for all employers, banks, childcare agencies etc. Failure to recertify on time will result in your rent going to contract rent for Section 8 residents, and market rent for Section 236 residents.
